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Dear Parents,

As another year begins, I would like to welcome you all back to Elliott Park School and extend a very warm welcome to Autumn and Jago who are joining our nursery group.

Here are some of the things we will be doing in the nursery this term: Our learning theme will be People Who Help Us. During the term we will divide the theme into topics that will include opportunities for writing and practising numbers. The focus will be as follows:

Week 1. Doctors and Nurses

Weeks 2 & 3. Vets

Weeks 4 & 5. Police

Week 6. Firefighters

You can extend your child's awareness of people who help us by looking out for signs in the community for fire, police, ambulance etc., talking about their role in keeping us safe and well. We will continue with early number skills, including: ordering, sorting, counting and shapes, space and measure along with lots of practical activities that help with fine motor skills in readiness for writing. We will also use the Hygiene Heroes story - demonstrating and practising good hygiene and hopefully learning that sharing germs is not good practice!

The children get chance to play outside every day and although we have waterproof, all in one suits for wet days, your child still needs a warm coat, hat, gloves and sturdy shoes (as not every day is a welly day).

World Book Day will be on 7th March, and although this is next term, we would like to give you advance notice of this. If your child attends nursery on Thursdays they are invited to come, on the 7th of March, dressed as their favourite book character for the day. This is not compulsory but will be lots of fun.
