<p>CH went over the minutes of the last meeting.</p> <p>Councillors were informed of the decision from the PTA on Christmas lunch choices. The Lunch will be provided by PTA at a small cost to parents. Lunch will be on the last Thursday of the term - 13th December, before the Christmas party.</p> <p>The PTA will serve lunch buffet style. It will consist of pizza, hotdogs, nuggets, fish fingers and chips, with a selection of soft drinks and followed by cupcakes.</p> <p>Children were asked to relay the following messages to their classmates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Toys, sweets and chewing gum are not allowed at school. If children bring any of these to school they will be confiscated until home time.• Children are entering the main school at playtime and lunchtime without permission. If children need to go to the toilet during breaktimes they must ask an adult; this is for their safety, so that we know where they are.• Children are playing around, in groups, in the toilet.
